




## Why do we SHINE?

Domestic violence is a community health issue.

1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men will experience abuse at some point in their lives.

In 2023, 17,086 requests for help in the KC region went unmet due to a lack of resources.

By working together, we can stop the cycle of abuse, address the barriers that feed it, and create generational healing.

Newhouse supports survivors of domestic violence with a 88-bed shelter, 24/7 crisis hotline, therapy, case management, legal advocacy, childcare, Early Learning Center, and much more.
